President's Report

- Snack Shack - second grade for January, first grade in February
- DeeDee Love on the Teacher's StrikeFebruary 26
 - SDEA negotiating team is still meeting with SDUSD to try reach resolution
 - 90% of SDUSD voted to authorize a 1-day unfair labor practice strike
 - Strike is about chronic understaffing and underfunding of special education; it is not about teacher pay
 - Teachers do not take a strike lightly, but this has been an ongoing issue for 7 years and is not improving, but getting worse
 - District repeatedly violates contract issues around contract special education funding
 - While the strike is about special education, it affects the entire school site
 - Parents can help at the federal level by signing a petition asking congress to follow through on federal funding
 - Parents can also help by joining an upcoming school board meeting on Jan 27, 2026 from 4-6pm and join teachers at the Strike on February 26 (more information to be shared)
