Spreckels's Running Club Rules

Running Club is supported by the PTA and run by parent volunteers. Children may sign up at any time and are welcome to come and log laps on any of the days the club meets. Loved ones are also encouraged to join in the fun. We ask that your child follow a few simple rules to help make the club fun and safe for everyone:

- Keep it fun, but no horse-play, rough-housing, throwing rocks/sticks/dirt, chasing, etc.
- Let's stay moving! You must run or walk at all times.
- Be fair: Go around the perimeter, no cutting, no running bases, etc.
- Keep track of your laps and let friends know how you did.
- Once on the field, students MUST stay until Running Club ends and the school gate opens.

Running Club is completely volunteer-run, and any misbehavior or inability to follow the rules will result in said student being unable to participate. If you think your child may have problems following the rules, we ask that you supervise for the duration of Running Club.
